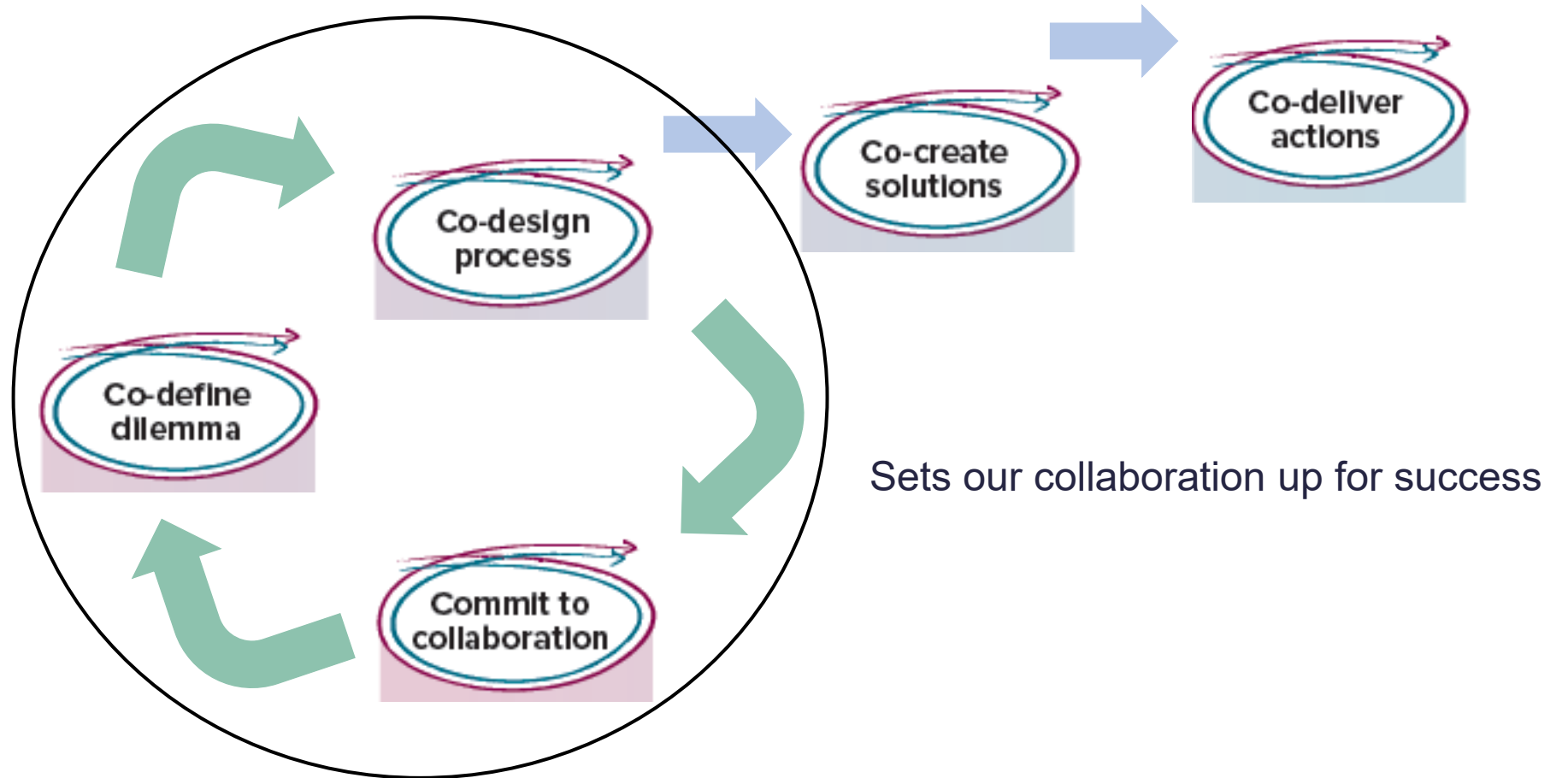
Strong community ties lead to better support for your projects, opportunities for collaboration, and ensure your project reflects what's important locally.
