





Our systems need to change – we have not created systems where all people and the planet thrive.



To create new futures we must also restore the past, we cannot ignore it.










This work is an approach to systems change that includes restoration, and the creation of new worlds from and with **mauri**, leading to a place of mauri ora – flowing, vital life force.



The Journey

- Two day online hui July/August
- 4-6 weekly online sessions of 2.5 hours five sessions (August to Feb) dates tbc
- A day hui to refine in March 2023
- Potential for a further in-person retreat for two days in the new financial year
- Potential for pair supervision and coaching
- A creative evaluation practice will be employed throughout



Criteria for entry

- You feel called to the work
- You can make the time required approx. 5 hours per month, plus prototyping (excluding the full day sessions)
- You are up for the depth and healing work in your own system you have done personal work of your own
- You are up for prototyping in your organisation
- Your organisation supports you to prototype
- You are up for looking at your own learning edges in this work
- You are up for a creative self evaluation process
- Commit to koha towards the Haumanu kaupapa

We will invite up to 20 people on the journey



Steps from here

- We will be establishing a Community of Practice through asking people to complete an Expression of Interest
